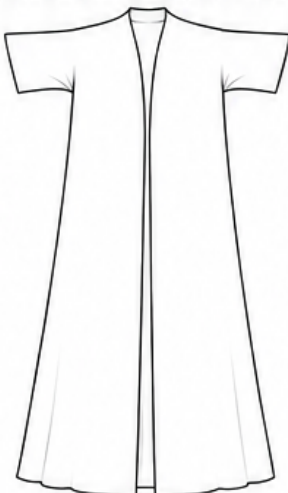

A long outer robe worn by both men and women.



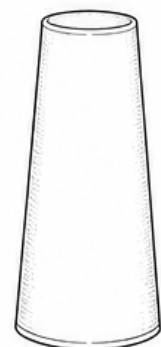
Gomlek
